





- Encourage researchers to take technology closer to market through a start up
- Stimulate enterprise formation

As part of this scheme, successful BIG Innovators receive up to **INR 50 lakh (approx. \$100K)** for research projects with commercialization potential with duration of up to 18 months.

Call announcement calendar:

The call for proposal is announced twice a year, i.e. on **1st January** and **1st July**. Call for proposals typically remains open for about 45 days.

The BIG Scheme is currently managed through **6 BIG Partners** across the country who works with the Ignition grantees (BIG Innovators) to provide mentoring, monitoring, networking and other business development related activities.




